Stretching throughout the Caribbean, the British Virgin Islands are a kaleidoscope of aquamarine waters, sun-soaked harbors, and white-sand beaches. Distinct ports of call can be found among the more than 25 pristine islands that make up the BVI. Throw away the to-do list and leave your day to chance, where you can search for turtles off the shores and find yourself gazing across the sea from a hilltop bar. Fill all your senses with spectacular scenery, delectable cuisine, and soft-sand beaches. The coral atoll of Anegada is the resting point of many a sunken ship and offers amazing underwater views for diving. From sprawling beaches to small villages you're sure find your own reason to cruise back on another return voyage.



A British Virgin Islands itinerary is extremely flexible. The cruising ground presents myriad opportunities for enjoyment. It's possible to go wherever the wind dictates, then pick up a mooring or drop the hook at a secluded anchorage to pass the hours snorkeling, swimming, sunbathing, reading, or walking on the beach. It's also possible to always remain in the thick of Caribbean action, stopping at marinas, savoring gourmet dinners at upscale restaurants, shopping in boutiques, and sightseeing in quaint towns. Most charterers choose a British Virgin Islands cruising itinerary that blends the best of both worlds: secluded anchorages and beautiful sunsets, a dash of the highly sophisticated at the resorts, and a bit of laid-back fun partying in the beachside bars.

Location may not be everything but in the British Virgin Islands it's what makes cruising so pleasurable. With its stretch of islands in the northeastern part of the Caribbean, charter guests can expect beautiful blue waters flowing into shaded caves and onto soft-sand beaches. Coral reefs surround the coast in an array of colors and are home to just as colorful marine life. Further inland bars, shops and restaurants spill through the winding streets and timeless villages are filled with the famous laid-back island ambiance.

Cost per cabin is \$5000 for Tradewinds Members and \$6000 for non-members. This rate includes your cabin. These prices are based on double occupancy.

Plan on meeting in Tortola at the Moorings base on Jan 5th. We will have an evening stay at the marina on the boat. The next morning after the skipper's briefing, we will leave the docks. After a week of exploring, we'll return to the Moorings base on Jan 13th by 10am. Then we will all disembark the boats and head back home.

The initial deposit to reserve a cabin is \$1000. The final payment of \$4000 for members and \$5000 for non-members is due September 1, 2023. Please pay close attention to the cancellation policy below.
