# American Sailing Association Courses

**Basic Keelboat**  
**3 Days of Instruction**  
**\$645 (\$495)**  
**ASA 101 certification**

BKB is taught on 25 foot Catalina Capris. You will learn the basics of sailing, how to get the boat moving, terminology, basic rules of the road, docking and more. Typically three 8 hour days of class with almost all of your time in the boats on the water.

**Basic Coastal Cruising**  
**3 Days of Instruction**  
**\$845 (\$695)**  
**ASA 103 certification**

BCC is taught on 27 to 30 foot boats, with inboard diesel engines. You will learn more advanced sailing, docking, anchoring, rules of the road, navigation, weather and more.

**Bareboat Charter**  
**3 Days of Instruction**  
**\$1045 (\$895)**  
**ASA 104 certification**

BBC is taught on 31 to 40 foot boats and includes an overnight at anchor somewhere on the Bay. You will learn advanced sailing techniques, high wind sailing, dual anchoring, navigation, boat systems and more.

**Coastal Navigation**  
**(Home Study) \$245 (\$225)**  
**ASA 105 certification**

This home study course on charts and navigation includes an ASA certified test administered in our office. The home study option is more difficult than it sounds. Coastal Navigation is a requirement for taking Advanced Coastal Cruising class.

**Coastal Navigation**  
**(Instructed) \$345 (\$325)**  
**ASA 105 certification**

The same material and test as the home study course above, but taught by an instructor. In this 2 day class you will learn charts, plotting, set and drift. Coastal Navigation is a requirement for taking Advanced Coastal Cruising class.

**Advanced Coastal Cruising**  
**3 Days of Instruction**  
**\$1395 (\$1295)**  
**ASA 106 certification**

ACC is taught on a large ocean yacht. This class covers advanced ocean sailing including navigation, standing watch, night-time MOB and much more. Three days and 2 nights, you'll typically go out the Golden Gate and turn left, spend a night in Half Moon Bay, sail around the Farallone Islands and anchor the second night in Drakes Bay.

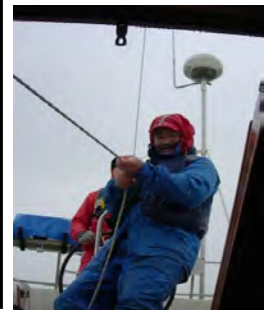
