happiness, respect and a calm nature.

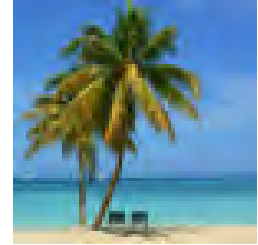


Our 2 week adventure will start by flying from San Francisco to Bangkok, where we will
